Y CRITERIA

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POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

CLASSIFICATION OF ADMISSIONS:

There are three classifications of admissions.

1.Regular Acceptance:

Applicants who meet all admission requirements are admitted as degree candidates with a regular status.

2.Provisional Acceptance: (Visiting students)

 Applicants who are accepted provisionally (result awaiting) or submit incomplete documents and sign an undertaking form mentioning the time frame within which they will furnish the documents.

 Transfer students who do not submit official documents from the institution previously attended fall in this category.

3.Non-Degree student status: (Certificate Course) Applicants who desire to take courses without seeking degree candidacy are designated as Non-Degree Students or as Certificate students as they take one or few courses from our degree programs and get a certificate for it by the end of the semester.

Zero Semester:

Students may be allotted a Zero Semester if they are considered deficient in certain skills in their interviews.

A placement evaluation is required for all students before being admitted. Places offered are valid for one term only; if not taken up, they are offered to applicants on the wait list.



Transfer of Credit / Advanced placement:

Students may apply for advanced placement keeping in view prior academic qualifications and experience.

Credits from other Institutions:

The Admission Office will evaluate credits from other institutions on a course-by-course basis in accordance with such agreements as may exist. The acceptability of each credit will depend on the appropriateness of the courses to the University curriculum, on their compatibility with courses offered by Greenwich University, the period since the course credits were earned, and the grade earned.

All passing grades of B or above in transfer courses are acceptable for students who leave their prior institution with good academic standing. Transfer credits will be awarded after the student has achieved good academic standing. However, a tentative evaluation of such transfer credits may be requested by the student upon admission. It is mandatory to provide the Original Official Transcript, Course Outlines and Prospectus of the University for the evaluation of the Transfer of Credits.

All transfer credit will be recorded as "TR" on the student's transcript. A maximum of 50% of courses can be transferred.

Credit by Challenge Examinations:

Students may obtain credit through successful performance on a challenge examination. A student seeking credit by examination must have an exceptional background in the subject and a minimum grade point average of 2.75. He or she must first secure written permission from the concerned Dean.

If permission is granted the Dean will arrange for preparation of challenge exam and may also require written reports, related supplementary readings, or a term paper if appropriate.

Forms for challenge examinations are available with the Registrar's Office / Communication Center.

Ownership of Documents:

All application material (academic records, financial support documents, test scores, reference letters, translations, and other material) submitted in support of an application, become the property of the University and cannot be returned or forwarded elsewhere, except the original documents which will be returned after verification.

Academic Probation

In case a student fails to maintain required minimum Grade Point Average (GPA), and uphold satisfactory academic progress for 03 consecutive semesters, the University reserves the right terminate admission of any student on probationary status, at any given time.

ADMISSION PROCESS:

STEP 1

Online / Face to Face Application:

Prospective students must first complete an online application form available on the Greenwich University website. This form requires personal details, educational background, program preferences and recommendation.

The Candidate can collect the Admission Form from Admission Office also.

STEP 2

Application Scrutiny:

After submitting the online application, the university's admission team reviews the application to ensure all required information is provided and meets the admission criteria.

STEP 3 University Placement Test:

The admission form needs to be filled out and submitted to the Admissions Office along with the required documents listed in the admission package.

STEP 4

Qualified applicants are invited for an interview, either in person or via video conferencing. The interview allows the university to assess the applicant's suitability for the chosen program and their motivation for pursuing higher education at Greenwich University.

STEP 5

Issuance of Acceptance Letter & Invoice:

Upon successful completion of the placement test and interview, the university issues an acceptance letter to the applicant. Along with the acceptance letter, an invoice detailing the tuition fees and other relevant charges is provided.

STEP 6

Payment of Fees:

To secure their place in the program, accepted applicants must make the required payment as per the invoice issued. Payment options and deadlines are outlined in the acceptance letter.

STEP 7

Provisional Acceptance:

Once the payment is received and processed by the university, provisional acceptance is granted to the student. This confirms their enrollment in the chosen program at Greenwich University.

It's essential for prospective students to closely follow each step of the online admission process and adhere to any deadlines specified by the university to ensure a smooth application experience.



Scholarships

Greenwich University has well established Financial Aid office extending need and merit based Financial Assistance to deserving candidates, following a generous policy.

The amount of scholarship offered is determined on a case-to-case basis.

Salient features of the Financial Assistance program are as follows:

- The amount of scholarship offered is determined based on need and merit. The fee concession ranges between 10% and 100%
- International students are offered 25% to 100% scholarship based on their country of origin and active admission campaigns to create diversity in student body
- Across the board, 25% fee concession is given to all those students who make it to the Dean's List based on their Grade Point Average (GPA). Qualifying GPA is 3.8 on a scale of 4 with the workload of 15 credit hours for Undergraduates, and 12 credit hours for Graduates degree programs
- The siblings of the registered students are given a fee concession of 25%
- The siblings of the alumni are also given a fee concession of 25%
- The siblings of staff qualify for a fee concession ranging from 25% to 100%
- The faculty of the University qualifies for fee concession ranging from 25% to 75% Sport based scholarship ranging from 25% to 100%


